

ABOUT THIS TRIP

The trip combines two unique parts of Africa and tow amazing species to catch on fly into a fly fishing adventure of note.

Start by spending 4 days fly fishing for tigerfish on the Rufiji River in Nyerere National Park, Tanzania surrounded by the sounds and wildlife of an African safari.

From there, it is on to 4 days of billfish on fly in Lamu Island, Kenya - a timeless coastal sand dune island on Kenya's northern shore.

This trip is privately guided by a region specific travel expert fluent in the local language who also happens to be a fly fishing guide for both tigerfish and billfish.

They will be with you every step of the way to ensure everything goes to plan and help you maximise your success on the water.





TIGERFISH ON THE RUFIFI

You will arrive into Nyerere National Park (Selous) and be met at the airstrip and taken to your accommodation at Kiba Point.


Kiba Point offers luxury accommodation overlooking the Rufiji River, with beautiful views across the water and the wild landscapes beyond.

Tiger fishing in the Selous is an unforgettable adventure and over the next 4 days you will fly fish both upstream and downstream from the Lodge on our specifically designed boat with our local guides.

Watch elephants and other wildlife while you cast your lines into the Rufiji River to battle the powerful, hard-fighting tigerfish amid the park's untamed beauty.


KIBA POINT ACCOMMODATION

Kiba Point offers private groups the unrestrained freedom of one of the world's biggest reserves, with exclusive guides and vehicles and a camp full of guilty, natural pleasures.

The camp features a central swimming pool - a relaxing retreat beneath thatched roofs and on the surrounding decks. Dining becomes an adventure with bush picnics and sandbar breakfasts adding a unique touch to the experience.

The camp has four separate rooms, each with a plunge pool. The rooms are large, open fronted, and raised with large verandas for the best possible views.

All rooms have en-suite bathrooms with flush toilets, indoor and outdoor showers, and hot water on demand. One room has a children's annex.






THE FISHING

Every year, around late October, thousands of sailfish migrate into the waters off Lamu Island.

The East African and Somali currents combine with silt from the river deltas creating nutrient-rich waters that hold a ton of baitfish, and it is this the bait that the sailfish come in hunting for.

BILLFISH ON FLY, LAMU ISLAND

LAMU ISLAND - ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS


Peponi Hotel - a family-run 4-star hotel on the northern tip of Lamu Island which has been operating since 1967.

Breakfasts are included during your stay at Peponi. Lunches and dinners can be ordered at the restaurant.






LAMU ISLAND - ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

Private House - Hidden away in a quiet corner of Shela Village on Lamu Island, this beautiful home comes with 3 double ensuite bedrooms spread over 2 floors with a stunning rooftop area.

It is the perfect home away from home for your fly fishing adventure.

The house pays tribute to beautiful Swahili architecture and is fully staffed with a chef, laundry, maid service and more.

It's a 5-min walk to the beach, Peponi Hotel, and to where you will meet your boat each day.


Jamie's passion for fly fishing is as infectious as the smile and energy he brings to every trip.

ITINERARY AT GLANCE

Having landed in Dar Es Salam, Tanzania in the morning, connect onto your internal flight to Nyerere National Park.

Check in to Kiba Point and enjoy 4 days of fly fishing for tigerfish in one of the wildest parts of Africa.

On day 5, depart the national park for Dar Es Salam and connecting flight to Nairobi. Overnight in Nairobi, and fly to Lamu Island the next morning.

Enjoy 4 days of billfish on fly at Lamu Island, and then fly to Nairobi for connecting flights back home.

PRICING

\$11300 per angler for 10 nights, 8 days fishing - minimum 4 anglers

- 9 Wt & 12 Wt fly lines plus spares
- 40 & 80 lbs fluorocarbon and wire leaders
- Billfish & tigerfish flies

IMPORTANT INFO

- Travel insurance with medical cover and evacuation is mandatory for all
- Broken rods and reels will be charged at the cost of a replacement
- Tips must be paid in cash in USD or GBP

- Sun cream
- Hats and buffs
- Polarised Sunglasses
- Long sleeved fishing shirts
- Light trousers for fishing in
- Wading boots/waterproof backpack
- Camera
- Mosquito repellent

GETTING THERE

From Europe - Flights to Dar Es Salam and from Nairobi Jomo Kenyatta International Airport are available from **Amsterdam, Paris, and London**. Other flights from hubs such as **Manchester, Lisbon, and Madrid** often require a change in Dubai or Dohar.

From USA - Direct flights with Kenya Airways from NYC are available to Nairobi, otherwise flying via London, Paris, Amsterdam, Dubai or Dohar is the best route.

Arrival Time

The best time to land at Dar Es Salam International Airport is early in the morning so that you can catch the Internal Flight to Nyerere National Park, avoiding a night in the capital.

If you arrive later in the day, we will arrange for you to stay at a hotel close to the airport with a free transfer so that you can relax before flying the next day.





TERMS & CONDITIONS

- A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to confirm the trip
- The final 50% is due 90 days before the trip start date
- Cancellations must be in writing and are effective on the date the cancellation is received
- For cancellations within 91 days or more of the trip start date, the deposit is forfeited unless the dates can be resold, in which case a 10% admin fee is charged
- For cancellations within 90 days or less of the trip start date, 100% of the trip cost is forfeited unless the client can find a replacement, in which case a 10% admin fee is charged
- If you fail to show up for the trip, arrive after the trip start date, or leave prior to the end of the trip, no reimbursement whatsoever will be made
