ABOUT LAMU & KIWAYU ISLANDS

Lamu Island is a timeless coastal gem on Kenya's northern shore — a UNESCO World Heritage Site steeped in Swahili history, where life moves at the pace of the tides.

With no cars, winding alleyways, and dhow sails dotting the sea, it offers a glimpse into a beautifully preserved culture.

Beyond its charm, Lamu & Kiwyau are a gateway to some of the richest inshore and offshore fisheries in East Africa, combining world-class fly fishing with authentic cultural immersion and laid-back island living.

The islands provide unparalleled access to some of the best offshore structures Kenya has to offer.

Days of fishing can be interspersed with visits to cultural centres, sunset sails in traditional Dhows, and lots more.





THE FISHING

Every year, in mid October, thousands of sailfish migrate into the waters off Lamu Island.

The East African and Somali currents combine with silt from the river deltas creating nutrient-rich waters that hold a ton of baitfish, and it's this bait that the sailfish cruise the ledges hunting for.

Some days you can see multiple sailfish finning as they feed and corral small fish on the surface. This is the perfect time to sight fish to them with a fly.

Expect to raise 6-20 fish on the teasers each day and maybe also have a few opportunities to cast at free swimmers on the surface.





OUR TEAM

Offshore - will fish from "Little Toot" a 31ft Blackfin powered by twin Perkins diesel engines.

The boat comes equipped with 2 shaded beds to relax on, a bathroom, and all the fishing gear you'll need to catch both marlin and sailfish on fly.

Our captain, and his three crew members have been fishing off Lamu for 30+ years and their wealth of experience puts us on the fish ensuring you get plenty of chances to catch billfish on fly.





LAMU ISLAND - ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS


Peponi Hotel - a family-run 4-star hotel on the northern tip of Lamu Island which has been operating since 1967.

Breakfasts are included during your stay at Peponi. Lunches and dinners can be ordered at the restaurant.






LAMU ISLAND - ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

Private House - Hidden away in a quiet corner of Shela Village on Lamu Island, this beautiful home comes with 3 double ensuite bedrooms spread over 2 floors with a stunning rooftop area.

It is the perfect home away from home for you fly fishing adventure.

The house pays tribute to beautiful Swahili architecture and is fully staffed with a chef, laundry, maid service and more.

It's a 5-min walk to the beach, Peponi Hotel, and to where you will meet your boat each day.





KIWAYU ISLAND - ACCOMMODATION

Mike's Camp - is one of the most unique island camps I have experienced. Beautifully laid out with sandy paths linking the rooms, to the bar, dinner table, and lounge area it is a remarkable place.

Each room is made from local materials, beautiful decorated in its own character, and comes with amazing sea views across the island.

Each evening, we will dine under the stars with the guests and owners of the lodge, sharing stories about our days on the water.

You will have your own private room while staying here. All meals are included while at Mike's Camp.

EXAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1 - Arrival Day

Having landed at Lamu Airport, Kenya you will be met by your host (Jamie). It is then a short walking to your boat taxi and a 20 min ride to Shela Village on Lamu Island. Jamie will escort you to your chosen accommodation and get you settled in.

Relax into paradise before a fly fishing coaching session at 4:30 pm on the beachfront with Jamie. We will run through casting practice, how to fish for billfish, tarpon, and other species to ensure you are ready to rumble on Day 1.

Day 2,3,4,5,6,7 - Fishing Days 1,2,3,4,5,6

Depending on our fishing location for the day, you will meet the boat either on the beach in front Peponi Hotel or Mikes Camp at 6:45am or later depending on the tides for the inshore fishing . You will have a full day of offshore/inshore fishing. Packed lunches, water, soft drinks and beers will be provided on the boat.

We will fish all day and plan to be back home for around 4pm on the inshore and up to 5pm when offshore.

Day 8 - Departure Day

Enjoy a lovely breakfast and a final dip in the Indian Ocean before checking out of your accommodation and hopping on a boat taxi to Lamu Airport for your flight to Nairobi and your connecting flights back home.



EXAMPLE PRICING

As all trips are tailor made, the pricing found here is based on a specific itinerary.

\$4290 per angler for 8 days, 7 nights, 6 days offshore fishing based on 3 anglers sharing

INCLUDES

- Pre-trip fly fishing coaching, online and/or in person
- 7 nights accommodation at the private house - with breakfast and a personal chef
- Private host & fly guide, onsite coaching during the trip
- 6 days of offshore fly fishing for billfish/on panga skiffs
- Packed lunches, soft drinks, and beers on fishing days
- Fly rod, reel rental
- Airport transfers from/to Lamu Airport and daily transfers to fishing if needed

- Beers & Cocktails (Beers are \$3.50 each)





GEAR LIST

FISHING

- 9 Wt & 12 Wt fly rod and saltwater reel
 - 9 Wt & 12 Wt fly lines plus spares
 - 15, 20, & 80 lbs fluorocarbon leaders
 - Tarpon flies, crab flies, shrimp flies
- *Rod, reel & 1 fly line hire are included the trip cost
- *Fly packs can be purchased for \$35 per person

IMPORTANT INFO

- Travel insurance with medical cover is mandatory for all
- Broken rods and reels will be charged at the cost of a replacement
- KSH are accepted in Kenya
- Tips must be paid in cash

GETTING TO LAMU ISLAND, KENYA

From Europe - Direct flights to Nairobi Jomo Kenyatta International Airport are available from **Amsterdam, Paris, and London**. Other flights from hubs such as **Manchester, Lisbon, and Madrid** often require a change in Dubai or Dohar.

From USA - Direct flights with Kenya Airways from NYC are available, otherwise flying via London, Dubai or Dohar is the best route.

Arrival In Kenya

The best time to land at Nairobi Jomo Kenyatta International Airport is in the early morning so that you can catch the Jambo Jet Flight to the Lamu Island that leaves at around 10am.


If you arrive later in the day, we will arrange for you to stay at a hotel close to the airport with a free transfer so that you can relax before flying to Lamu the next day.





TERMS & CONDITIONS

- A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to confirm the trip
- The final 50% is due 90 days before the trip start date
- Cancellations must be in writing and are effective on the date the cancellation is received
- For cancellations within 91 days or more of the trip start date, the deposit is forfeited unless the dates can be resold, in which case a 10% admin fee is charged
- For cancellations within 90 days or less of the trip start date, 100% of the trip cost is forfeited unless the client can find a replacement, in which case a 10% admin fee is charged
- If you fail to show up for the trip, arrive after the trip start date, or leave prior to the end of the trip, no reimbursement whatsoever will be made
